House Bill 1045

Dear ASP Executives:

As you may already know, we are in the midst of some interesting and potentially eventful times at SCF Arizona and we want to make sure you hear directly from us as circumstances unfold.

SCF Arizona has operated for many years as a hybrid company that is not fully private, and that is not a public agency – and that still operates under enabling statutes created by the legislature.

Over the course of the past week, events have begun to take place that may result in converting SCF Arizona into a mutual insurance company and eliminating the state compensation fund.

In the process of conducting our standard, “Sunset Review”, a formality that occurs every 10 years in the state legislature as prescribed by our enabling statute, Senate President Bob Burns decided to introduce a bill that, if passed, will result in SCF becoming a private company.

Work on the bill is not complete. The specific details are still being finalized and hearings will be held on Wednesday, April 7th.

While we did not initiate this action, SCF Arizona has long held this view and we welcome the change, and the opportunity to compete on a level playing field. We support the proposed legislation.

This is a fluid process and there are many details to be worked out. We will keep you informed.

It is important for you to know that as much as this means potential change for the company, it really does not fundamentally change the day-to-day focus of the company you have been dealing with in recent years. We will continue to make injured workers and their employers our focus and we will continue to make small businesses the backbone of our policyholder base.

Again, nothing is certain at this point but we wanted you to hear from us as this public process begins.

Every relationship we have is unique and individual and we know that everyone will have different questions.
